



**Aeronautics-Pilot Training
Admissions Process Guide**
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The process outlined by this guide is to help you comply with many federal and state regulations. Carefully read and follow each step in its entirety as failure to fully and completely comply with all steps outlined in this guide results in ineligibility for program acceptance.

NOTE ITEMS:

The Aeronautics Program at Fox Valley Technical College operates based on a first-come, first served policy per the Wisconsin Technical College System.

- The Aeronautics program is in high-demand and we see a high volume of interest; please plan accordingly.
 - To most efficiently serve the students in this high demand area, the program operates on a constant out/constant in model.
 - If your position is such that you are eligible to enroll in core courses for the next available start, but do not, you may bypass that spot. Please note that if you bypass a spot, you may need to meet with an academic advisor and flight instructor to discuss your interest in the program.
 - After successful completion of Phase I, students will be officially admitted to the college.
 - Attendance to a New Student Orientation session is mandatory. These are typically offered three times a year; please plan accordingly.
 - Once students are admitted to the college, successful completion of the tasks outlined within Phase II of this guide will be mandatory for the Aeronautics program and official FAA Part-141 enrollment. Failure to complete any of the necessary steps will result in delayed start or program withdrawal.

(To-do list on far-right side of login page) Clicking To-Do List Details provides additional detail on each task. *NOTE – Items in your To-Do list labeled as “equested” are items you must complete or require your attention.
 - Students are required to assess their finances and make arrangements to have payment available prior to the first day of flight courses. We encourage students to apply for Financial Aid (if necessary) and to review the previous year’s academic planner for estimate course costs (*course fees are subject to change). Documentation Guidelines & Compliance:

The Aeronautics Program requires students to submit many documents that are required by Fox Valley Technical College, the Federal Aviation Administration and Transportation Security Administration. Please view the items below to see the submission requirements. Please ensure all of your documentation meets compliance standards. If documentation does not meet the following criteria, students will be asked to resubmit their items:

- Full-color
- No corners or wording have been cut off
- All information is current and legible

Verification of Citizenship

- **Current U.S. Passport:** scan image of current, signed and open passport
- **Official Birth Certificate & Driver's License:**
 - i. Birth Certificate: scan image of full birth certificate (front only)
 - ii. Driver's License: scan image of front & back of license; ensure all images are clear.
- **Certificate of Naturalization & Driver's License:**
 - i. Certificate of Naturalization: scan image of full certificate of naturalization
 - ii. Driver's License: scan image of front & back of license; ensure all images are clear.

1st or 2nd Class FAA Medical Certificate

- Confirm FAA Medical Certificate is signed & has been issued within the last 12 calendar months.
- Scan copy of original medical and submit as stated on page 7
 - o Please remember FAA prohibits tampering with document; lamination, removing conditions of issue, etc.

Student Pilot or Current Pilot Certificate:

- Confirm certificate is signed
- Scan images of front & back of pilot certificate as outlined on page 6

Complete Skills Assessment

An academic skills assessment is required for admission into the Aeronautics-Pilot Training program or the following: provide completion of an associate's or higher degree **OR**; 165 or higher on your 2014 series GED tests **OR**; 2.75+ high school GPA (within the last 10 years) **OR**; ACT or SAT or Accuplacer or Companion or Compass (within the last three years) to waive to the general education level. Students need the following minimum scores OR Equivalent Program Prep Course(s):

Accuplacer Algebra Score **250** or ACT Math **18**

Accuplacer Sentence Skills Score **250** or ACT English **18**

Accuplacer Reading Score **250** or ACT Reading **18**

Verification of Citizenship: The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) has issued regulations that require flight schools – including FVTC – for students to show proof of U.S. Citizenship. Using the Documentation Guidelines as listed on page 4, submit your official citizenship documents.

Current United States Passport, **OR**

Official Birth Certificate **and** Driver's License **OR**

Certificate of Naturalization **and** Driver's License

Phase I - Admissions Requirements & New Student Orientation, Continued.

Obtain a 1st or 2nd Class FAA Medical Certificate

Submit a scanned copy of your original signed **1st or 2nd Class FAA Medical Certificate** issued within the last 12 months by an FAA-approved Aviation Medical Examiner (AME).

Note Items:

*3rd Class FAA Medical Certificates are **NOT** acceptable

*Locate the nearest Aviation Medical Examiner at the following webpage: <http://www.faa.gov/pilots/amelocator>

*Students with any medical concerns are encouraged to complete this step early to avoid enrollment delays due

to medical evaluations that may be needed.

***After medical is scheduled, please follow specific instructions per the Aviation Medical Examiner.**

Reminder: Students must renew their 1st or 2nd Class FAA Medical Certificate every 12 calendar months while on the flight ready list and enrolled in flight training at FVTC. Failure to present a current medical certificate when the other expires will result in removal from the flight ready list.

Submit Student Pilot or Current Pilot Certificate

Student or Current Pilot Certificate Holders: submit a scanned copy of your signed certificate.

New Applicants:

1. Visit <https://iacra.faa.gov/IACRA/Default.aspx> and follow the New User Guide process.

2. After filling out your application, contact Flight Instructor, Designated Pilot Examiner or FAA Inspector to schedule a time to complete application. ****This step can be completed with a Flight Instructor at FVTC.***

Instructors are available following the New Student Orientation*

3. Submit copy of your signed Official Student Pilot Certificate once you receive it.

Note Items:

i. Please note that the FAR AIM indicates that FAR 61.83 Eligibility requirements for student pilots: to be eligible for a student pilot certificate, an applicant must:

(a) be at least 16 years of age for other than the operation of a glider or balloon.

(b) be at least 14 years of age for the operation of a glider or balloon

(c) be able to read, speak, write and understand the English language. If the applicant is unable to meet one of these requirements due to medical reasons, the administrator may place such operating limitations on that applicant's pilot certificate as are necessary for the safe operation of the aircraft.

ii. This process will take a **few weeks** for the TSA to complete required background checks and may take longer to receive your FAA issued certificate. Be sure to plan ahead and start this step early. You can monitor your status on the FAA's Airman Certification website:

iii. Students need to have a current U.S. Passport OR Real ID to complete this process (Real ID-compliant licenses are marked with a star in the upper right-hand corner).

Phase II – FAA Equipment Verification & Official Part 141 Enrollment (Once Admitted)

Objective: complete these requirements to be eligible to enroll into Fox Valley Technical College's FAA Part-141 Aeronautics Program. Students have the option to complete the tasks within Phase II at any point. Students will be sent a reminder communication from an FVTC staff member as to when they should begin their tasks. Students who do not successfully meet compliance will be ineligible to move forward. Please read all pertinent details below.

*Please Note: students will receive a reminder email communication when they are within the Top 10 and Top 5 on the **Flight Ready List**.*
