Dual Credit

A Dual Credit class is a technical college course taught by a Fox Valley Technical College Dual Credit certified high school teacher at the high school. A high school student earns credit at their high school and at the technical college at no cost to the student or their school district.

Earned credits through Dual Credit and Start College Now can be used to further reduce the price of a degree at Fox Valley Tech.



Compare Fox Valley Technical College tuition with four-year public or private colleges and universities.*


Credit Value
